ALCESTER FIRST RESPONDERS RAN A DEFIBRILLATOR TRAINING COURSE FOR COUGHTON VILLAGERS RECENTLY. THANKS TO THIS, TWO VILLAGERS WERE ABLE TO RECOGNISE THE SYMPTOMS OF A HEART ATTACK WHEN CLLR ROY PIDDINGTON FELT UNWELL. AFTER CALLING 999 AND BEING TOLD IT WAS A 2 - 3 HOUR WAIT FOR AN AMBULANCE, DESPITE THE SEVERITY OF THE ISSUE, THE NEIGHBOURS MANAGED TO GET ROY, SLOWLY AND STEADILY INTO THEIR CAR AND TOOK HIM DIRECTLY TO THE ALEXANDRA HOSPITAL. HE WAS RUSHED STRAIGHT THROUGH TO THE CARDIAC DEPARTMENT, WHERE THEY CONFIRMED HE WAS HAVING A HEART ATTACK. ROY WAS BLUE LIGHTED TO WORCESTER CARDIAC DEPT AND HE UNDERWENT SURGERY TO INSERT STENTS. IF IT HADN'T BEEN FOR THE DEFIBRILLATOR TRAINING, ROY'S HEART ATTACK MAY NOT HAVE BEEN RECOGNISED. I WOULD HIGHLY RECOMMEND TO EVERYONE TO UNDERTAKE THIS TRAINING AS YOU TOO MAY SAVE A LIFE.


