Incidents of a public interest from the last week:-

COUGHTON

- *Anti-Social Behaviour. Private Heart of England land, Coughton. Report of 4x4 vehicles on the land causing damage and a general nuisance. Ongoing problem. No trace on police arrival. 8pm Wednesday 12th May. 0390 12/05/2021

Jack Stephens – Missing - Appeal to help find missing 14-year-old Jack Stephens. We are appealing for information to help locate 14-year-old Jack Stephens. Jack went missing from Nottinghamshire on 14 April 2021. It is believed that he may now be in the Alcester District. Jack is 5'7" and has short black wavy hair. Officers are concerned for Jack's welfare. Anyone with information that could help to locate him should call police straight away. Crimestoppers – Crimestoppers is an independent charity that gives you the power to speak up to stop crime, 100% anonymously. This can be done by phone and online, 24/7, 365 days a year. After receiving a call or a completed anonymous online form, crimestoppers creates a report that brings together all the information given making sure it doesn't contain any information that could identify the caller. The report is then sent to the relevant authority with the legal responsibility to investigate crimes, make arrests and charge people in order to bring them to justice.
